## Hikes in the Camden Hills

### Two Hour Sunrise, Nature, or Bird Hike

**\$55 per person, two person minimum**

2-hour sunrise, nature-photo hike in the Camden Hills State park, or other location in the Camden Rockport area identifying the local plants, trees, birds, animals. Visit great locations to take photos, places to learn about flora and fauna, plus local history. Provide your own transportation to and from the trail head. Water bottle required, and sturdy walking shoes recommended.

### Four Hour Camden Hills Moderate Day Hike

**\$110 per person, two person minimum**

4-hour hike - Hike up Maiden's Cliff, Mt. Battie, Bald Rock, or Bald Mountain. Snacks included. Great vistas, moderate difficulty. Provide your own transportation to and from the trail head. Water bottle and sturdy hiking shoes required.

### Six Hour Camden Hills Strenuous Day Hike

**\$165 per person, two person minimum**

6-hour hike - Hike from the State Park entrance in Lincolnville, through the park along the access road to Camden. Bag a peak or two along the way, depending on level of challenge desired. Peaks could include Zeke's Lookout, Mount Megunticook, Mount Battie, or Bald Rock. Lunch provided. Provide your own transportation to and from the trail head. Water bottle and sturdy hiking shoes required.

Six-hour hikes – Moderate or Strenuous - Depart early morning for an early morning arrival at the park. Travel the loop road to one of many hikes in the park. # **Maine Guided Trips**

All day trip – Strenuous - Leave early morning from Rockport. Climb Maine’s tallest and most challenging peak. See spectacular vistas, possibly moose, and lots of other wildlife. This is a very special park set up by Percival Baxter to remain, “Forever Wild.” All told this can be a 16-hour day (Including travel to and from Rockport and, ten hours of hiking. strenuous and weather permitting) Lunch and snacks provided. See gear list below.

## **Maine Mountains**

**\$390 per person, two person minimum**

All day trip - Hike Maine’s lesser known mountains like Tumbledown, Doubletop, Elephant, or Kineo. This is an opportunity to get off the beaten path while enjoying other Maine ecosystems. Lunch and snack provided. Provide your own transportation, or I will meet you. Water bottle and sturdy hiking shoes required.

**\$545 per person, two person minimum**

# Maine Guided Trips

The two-day trip starts at the Togue Pond Gate at Baxter State Park. We will arrive in the mid afternoon and set up camp for the night, either camping in tents, or lean-tos. We will depart early in the morning and return ten to twelve hours later. Trail options include the Helon Taylor trail up Pamola and over the Knives Edge to Baxter Peak, returning to Roaring Brook via the Saddle Trail and Chimney pond. We would then drive to our vehicles for the return.

**NOTES:** As Baxter State Park is very popular, reservations need to be made well in advance, and alternative itineraries may be required. Please note that the required equipment list is NOT optional and we reserve the right to cancel without refund for adventurers who show up not fully prepared for the trip. If you need gear that is on the required list please let me know before departure. This is a strenuous trip and not suitable for most young people under the age of 16. Other travel arrangements can be made. Note: Does not including park fees +/- \$35

## Three-day Overnight Trip Up Katahdin

**\$940 per person, two person minimum**

The three-day trip up Katahdin is a nice way to break up the strenuous trip up Katahdin into three days. We would depart Togue Pond Gate at Baxter State Park by ten o'clock and hike three miles from Roaring Brook with packed food and gear to Chimney Pond. Your guide will prepare tasty food before you retire in this amazing spot which you will have time to explore. We will camp in a lean-to, bunk house, or tent site for the night. Next morning hike to the peak of Mount Katahdin via the Cathedral, or Saddle trail. If there is enough time, interest, and the weather cooperates, we can hike part of the Knife's Edge, or over to Hamlin Peak returning that evening to Chimney Pond for more delicious guide-cooked food. After a good night's sleep, we will pack out our gear from Chimney Pond to Roaring Brook, returning in our cars from whence we came!

**NOTES:** As Baxter State Park is very popular, reservations need to be made well in advance, and alternative itineraries may be required. Please note that the required equipment list is NOT optional and we reserve the right to cancel without refund for adventurers who show up not fully prepared for the trip. If you need gear that is on the required list please let me know before departure. This is a strenuous trip and not suitable for most young people under the age of 16. Other travel arrangements can be made. Note: Does not including park fees +/- \$45

**NEW\* Vinal Haven E-Bike Geology Tour\*NEW**

**\$225 per person, two person minimum**

# Maine Guided Trips

All day E-Bike tour of ancient volcano. Meet at the Ferry terminal in Rockland at 8:15am to get the 8:45 am ferry to Vinal Haven. E-Bikes will be there to meet you! Take them onboard for the one hour and fifteen minute ferry ride to Carver's Harbor on Vinal Haven. Once off the ferry, head to the northwestern head of the island on our bikes for a lunch at Brown's Head Light. While there, head down to the shore to see evidence of volcanic ash droplets called lapilli. Then, heading south, making a two stops mid island we will visit two to three other sites with evidence of ancient volcanic activity. If working, we will visit a working stone cutter. Heading back into town we will visit the Vinalhaven historical society museum, followed by a visit to pyroclastic pillows along the southern shore of Vinalhaven Island. We will then head back to the ferry terminal for our ride back to the mainland. Trip departs at 8:15 am and returns to Rockland by 4:30 in time for a nice dinner on your own in the area. This trip is filled with breathtaking views of Penobscot Bay (weather permitting), geology information, history of Maine, and physical exercise. A great combination! Adventurers, two one liter water bottles per person, day pack, hat, sunscreen, and if you get seasick at all, take what you need to be comfortable on a one and one quarter hour boat ride, and four hours of E-bike riding. Lunch, snacks, and ferry fees provided.

## **Maine Island Trips via Ferry**

**\$180 per person, two person minimum**

All day trip - Travel on a Maine state ferry, or charter boat, to a Maine island for exploration of the natural history, and local Maine history. Enjoy a picnic lunch with time to explore, swim, walk around the island. Bring your camera! Come back with a new appreciation for Maine's marine wilderness preserved on Maine's Islands. Water bottle required and sturdy shoes required. Lunch, snacks, and ferry fees provided.

## **Maine Island Trips via Charter**

All day trip - Travel on a charter boat, to a Maine Island for exploration of the natural history, and local Maine history. Enjoy a picnic lunch with time to explore, swim, walk around the island. Lunch, snacks, and charter fee provided.

## **Maine Sea Kayaking Trips**

### **NEW\* Two Hour Sea Kayak Lighthouse \*NEW**

#### **Tour of Rockport Harbor**

**\$90 per person, two person minimum**

Meet in Rockport Harbor where we will launch after a short training and safety briefing. Paddle along the eastern shore of Rockport Harbor taking in the beautiful views off of Beauchamp Point, passing an osprey nest on Seal ledge, weather and tide permitting, circumnavigating Indian Point with its quaint lighthouse, and returning along the western shore of Rockport Harbor with its bold, rocky shore.

All kayaking gear provided. Participants provide hats, sun block, water bottles, cameras, sunglasses, and light jackets. Adventurers should wear clothing and footwear that may get damp.

### **NEW\* Four Hour Sea Kayak Tour to Birch Island \*NEW**

**\$165 per person, two person minimum**

Meet at Birch Point State Park in South Thomaston, Maine at 9:00am. After about a half an hour getting into gear, and safety briefing, we will be on our way on the little over two mile journey across Muscle Ridge to our lunch destination, Birch Island. After the provided lunch we will do some “gunkholing,” or paddling into the nooks and crannies on Maine islands like Dix, High, and Nettle. We would then return to Birch Point Beach. We will return by two o’clock with plenty of time for you to have a relaxed afternoon followed by an epicurean treat at one of our local restaurants.

All kayaking gear provided. Participants provide hats, sun block, water bottles, cameras, sunglasses, and light jackets. Adventurers should wear clothing and footwear that may get damp.

### **NEW\* Overnight Maine Island Sea Kayak Tour \*NEW**

**\$240 per person, four person minimum**

Take advantage of the Maine Island Trail and other Maine island sites for nights camping on beautiful Penobscot Bay. These trips require sea kayaking experience on the ocean as we will be on our own to get to our destinations and return safely. Departure and arrival locations to be determined based on customer collaboration. These trips can be moderately strenuous to strenuous. Participants will have to pitch in shuttling gear both in kayaks, as well as well as on land. Leave No Trace requirements to camp on Maine Islands require a packing in/packing out all waste.
